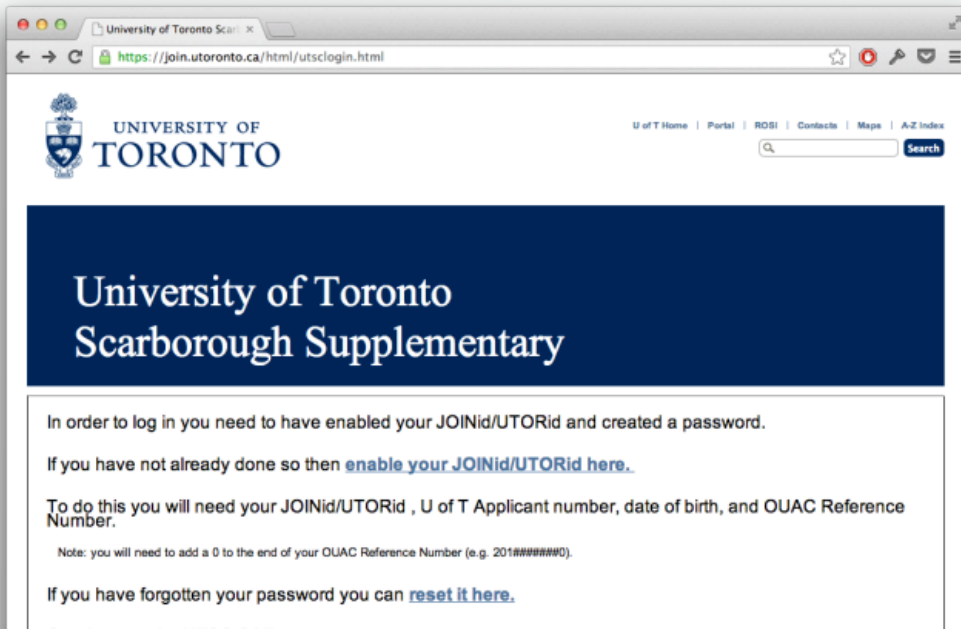

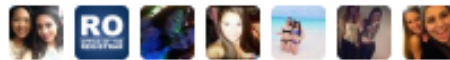

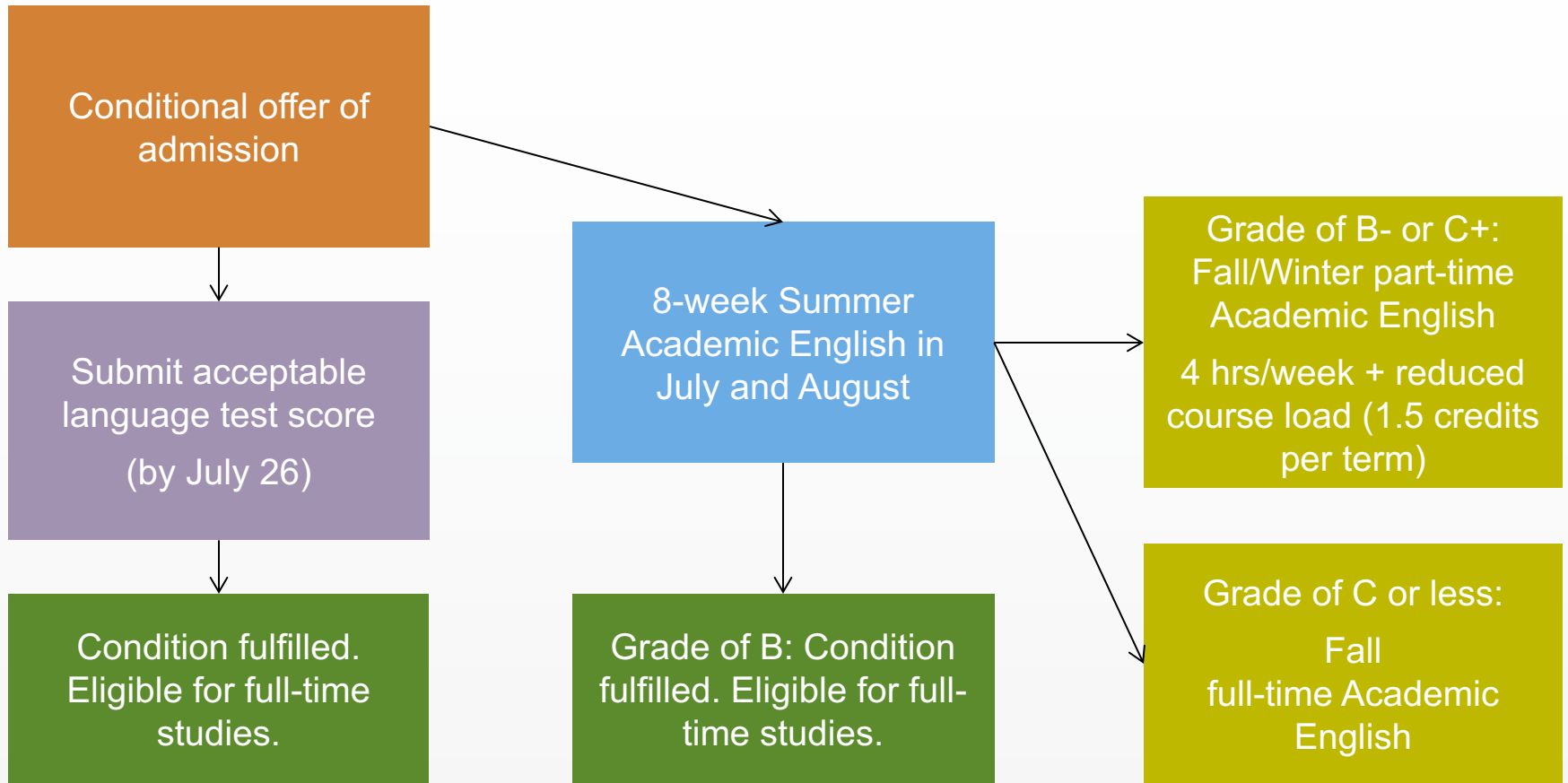

- Alternate offer is given to those who just miss the selection level
- Given in recognition of achievement
- Allows for enrolment in a academic area that is related to what student applied for
- Entry into original program is possible after first year
- May include Academic English Alternate and Redirect Offers to Seneca College

UTSC now has defined criteria for awarding guaranteed entrance scholarships to all domestic and international students studying in Canadian secondary schools who are admitted to U of T Scarborough.

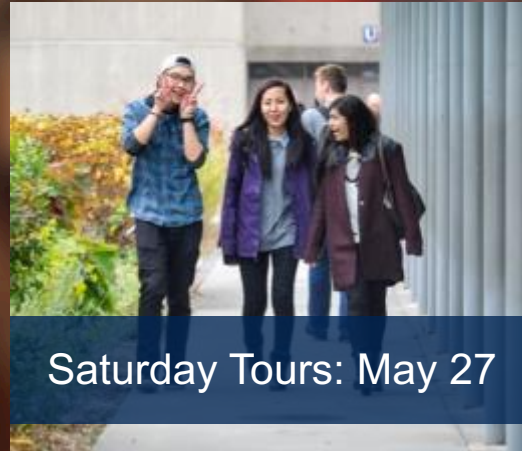
HOW TO HAVE A SUCCESSFUL TRANSITION
