Date:21 September 2020Re:UPDATE: On-campus Hiring of Co-op Students in COVID-19 Context

As outlined in <u>MEMORANDUM DCD #7, 2019-20</u> the VP Dean's Office continues to encourage academic units and faculty across campus to consider hiring co-op students. Not only are students financially affected by the co-op hiring freezes, but so also is their ability to complete program requirements. The federal government continues to provide the **Student Work Placement Program (SWPP)** subsidy, which covers 50-70% (\$5,000-\$7,000) of the domestic co-op student salary.

The VP Dean's Office also has funding available for several U of T Scarborough international student positions to compensate for their ineligibility for federal support, while recognizing their important contributions, and in the spirit of inclusive excellence and equity.

A talented pool of students in the current hiring cycle are looking for employment in the Winter 2021 term. Staff and faculty members are encouraged to plan this recruitment process now. Keep in mind that these students will continue to work full time hours remotely if required and have flexibility with start and end dates.
