The Office of the Vice-Principal Academic & Dean is pleased to launch a new Postdoctoral Fellow program on a pilot basis - <u>Postdoctoral Fellow - Job Posting</u>. Based on a proposal authored by Dr. Aarthi Ashok, Professor, Teaching Stream; Biological Sciences, the focus of this program is scholars who are interested in research related to the Scholarship of Teaching & Learning (SoTL) and in careers that focus on teaching at a university level.

We expect that the Fellow would have not only rigorous disciplinary training, but also a strong interest in student-centred education. The hired Fellow would enhance and renew undergraduate curricula by designing innovative teaching strategies. Applicants will need to identify a Teaching Stream faculty member to act as a mentor. The position includes 1.0 FCE of teaching, so consultation will also be needed with the Department Chair.
