Dear colleagues,

I am enclosing below some updates and reminders of resources to support departments and faculty in planning for Winter courses. Please share this information with faculty and TAs who will be teaching next term.

- 1) Absence self-declaration form: The student absence self-declaration form will continue to be in effect in the Winter term, with the duration period shortened from 14 days to 7 days. Faculty members should not be requesting verification of illness forms to reduce pressures on the Health & Wellness Centre and on the broader health care system. A revised, longer-term version of the absence self-declaration form is being developed for Fall 2023.
- 2) Resources for students: As we continue to navigate the transition back to in-person learning along with the evolving pandemic context, a consolidated list of student support resources developed by the Office of Student Experience & Wellbeing can be found on the Healthy Campus website. The Centre for Teaching & Learning also offers a range of academic learning supports for students, including English language development; writing; math, and stats; and facilitated study groups.
