Since September 2020, Professor Jessica Fields has served as the Special Advisor to the VP Dean on the Transitional Year Program (TYP) at U of T Scarborough, and recently was appointed as the Vice-Dean Faculty Affairs, Equity & Success (VDFAES), starting 1 July 2021.
