The VDGPS will address the following key areas of responsibility with an Inclusive Excellence lens:

- Provide leadership and administrative oversight of graduate programs and life-long learning initiatives
- Coordinate the development, and regular review, of graduate units and programs
- Provide guidance for graduate student admissions, registration, and support and tracking of their academic progress
- Administer the Inclusive Excellence Postdoctoral Fellowship Program
- Oversee Teaching Assistant Training Program (TATPs)
- Support Labour Relations: CUPE Unit 1 and CUPE Unit 5
- Administer campus-level graduate student and postdoctoral fellow funding and scholarships/awards
- Support the building of a community of graduate students and postdoctoral fellows at U of T Scarborough
- Liaise with the School of Graduate Studies (SGS) on graduate student and postdoctoral fellow matters, including academic integrity
- Mentoring, professional development and other supports for graduate students and post-doctoral fellows in collaboration with Office Vice-Principal Research & Innovation (VPRI)
