Re: **Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for Faculty**

In light of the amount and sophistication of phishing attacks, the university has implemented the [DUO Multi-Factor Authentication \(MFA\)](#) system to provide an additional layer of security to be able to access University of Toronto web resources. MFA is a security enhancement that requires two sets of different credentials before granting users access to an account (i.e., your password paired with a code sent to your mobile phone). The new authentication service is referred to as UTORMFA.

The installation of the Duo Mobile app just takes a few minutes. For more information:
