Re: Call for Nominations, Teaching Stream Faculty Working Group, University of Toronto Scarborough Note: For broad distribution

The Vice-Dean Faculty Affairs, Equity & Success is forming a Teaching Stream Faculty Working Group to identify barriers and opportunities to pedagogical and professional achievement and to support the success of Teaching Stream faculty across a range of career stages. The group will meet monthly January 2022 to June 2022, with a goal of producing a report with recommendations by 31 August 2022.

In accordance with the <u>U of T Scarborough Teaching Stream Faculty Working Group Terms of Reference</u>, the Working Group will include stakeholders from across campus, with core representation and co-leadership from Teaching Stream faculty in the Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Professor ranks. I write to invite nominations and self-nominations of faculty members and administrative leaders to serve on the Working Group. We aim to ensure a diversity of perspectives and experiences, including (but not limited to) disciplinary and pedagogical breadth; Indigenous, Black, and racialized perspectives; gender and sexual diversity; and a range of career stages and ranks.

Nominations should be submitted no later than Friday, 14 January 2022, by filling out the <u>nomination form</u>. Please include a brief description of your reasons for suggesting each person you name.
