The Academic Integrity Office (AIO) team has worked very hard over the past year to reduce case backlogs, to process new cases in a timely and efficient manner, and to increase our education and awareness initiatives to assist students. In a few months we will be rolling out a new, integrated platform to help instructors navigate the academic integrity process more efficiently and to further enhance our service to you and to our students.
