The seminar presentation and paper provide an opportunity for you to examine a topic in greater depth.

Since this class is a seminar, participation in class discussion throughout the term is important.

There are four components to the final grade, each weighted as follows:

Examination: 35%
Paper: 25%
Seminar presentation: 20%
Participation in seminar discussion: 20%
