**Course Content:** This course focuses on theory and research concerning issues in the area of socialization. In the first part of the term, we will examine the topics of moral judgment, the development of internalized control over behaviour and the contribution of sociocultural factors to moral development. In the second part of the term, students will have an opportunity to examine other selected issues in the area of socialization in the context of class presentations.

**Course Policy:** In addition to lecture/discussion (first part of the term), there will be class presentations in the second part of the term concerning salient controversies in this area of research. Each student will choose a topic early in the term from a list provided by the instructor. Each student will also submit a paper on that topic.

**Evaluation:**
