Course Overview

This course covers research methodology in social psychology, including learning about specific techniques, such as attitude measurement, and also, more general principles of design and methodology. There will be two class projects, intended to give you first-hand experience with research approaches used in social psychological research.

Evaluation

For each of the two class projects, there is a paper based on the project. You will receive detailed information about the project and the format for the paper based on each project during the term. In addition, there will be one examination, covering the required reading in your text throughout the entire term, as well as material presented in class during the term. This examination will take place during the final exam period.
